SUBJECT: 341 MW Endorsement Memorandum on Combating Trafficking in Persons

1. Trafficking in Persons (TIP) is the recruitment, transportation, transfer, harboring or receipt of persons by means of threat, use of force, coercion, abduction, fraud, deception, abuse or exploitation. TIP is the second largest criminal activity in the world and a threat to worldwide security, human rights and stability, as well as a direct threat to our national foreign policy goals. Due to the seriousness of this crime, the adverse results in terms of human tragedy and the disabling impact on our military readiness, the Air Force has established a “zero tolerance” for trafficking in persons.

2. I fully endorse the Air Force’s “zero tolerance” for TIP. I expect all members of Malmstrom AFB to be aware of the negative impacts TIP could have on our mission readiness and professional climate. All airmen must be aware of the establishments that are considered “Off-Limits”. In addition, each Airmen must be able to identify and report any suspicious behavior that may indicate TIP activities to your chain of command, Security Forces, AFOSI or Inspector General.
