SUBJECT: Environmental Commitment Statement

- 1. At Malmstrom Air Force Base, protecting the environment is an important priority, and is a key enabler to our mission assurance. I expect all personnel to factor in environmental considerations as they make decisions during their daily duties, and to be in full compliance with all environmental requirements. We will use an Environmental Management System (EMS) approach for establishing and reviewing environmental objectives.
- 2. The scope of Malmstrom's EMS encompasses all activities, services, and products associated with sustaining operations, and also includes all organizations, tenants, and mission partners operating on main base, and throughout our entire missile field complex to include 15 Missile Alert Facilities and 150 Launch Facilities.
- 3. Malmstrom AFB is committed to continued excellence, leadership, and stewardship in protecting the environment. Our specific mission includes providing mission-ready Airmen and equipment, outstanding support to Team Malmstrom, and supreme care to our people. Environmental concerns for this regional/local area include air and water quality, hazardous materials and waste, natural and cultural resources, restoration, PFAS/PFOA, and storage tanks. In all our activities, we seek to:
- a. Achieve high levels of environmental performance and to the maximum extent possible, ensure full compliance with all Federal, state, local and AF/DOD policies, directives, and Executive Orders as we strive to reduce pollution and expand the use of sustainable resources.
- b. Evaluate the compliance risk burden of existing processes and work to reduce that burden through equipment, material substitutions, and process improvements.
- c. Conduct our environmental, transportation, and energy-related activities in support of the mission in an efficient, integrated, and fiscally sound manner.
- d. Empower our EMS Cross-Functional Team (CFT) to develop, review and update environmental aspects, impacts, objectives and targets IAW AFI 32-7001.
